day. Sent my Opera glass to Ellen as she wished
to borrow it. Mrs. G. called - it better some but
not in good spirits. Read in Ezekiel & papers &
Fri 8.

Cold & not very pleasant. Warmed a potato & some of my
cold graham mush in butter & cooked an egg in shell
in hot, not boiling water for my breakfast, & I ate
a piece of fruit cake that Feltie Derby brought to
me this morning. & she gave me $3\frac{3}{4}$ lbs of beef.
The cake was extra good. & I am boiling the fresh beef

it. I do not feel well - stomach sour & squally -
