Sun 24

Rainy A.M. Clear P.M. & a nice moonlit evening - Had lemon-
ade & crackers & warmed graham mush for ^{hash} ~~Biscuits~~ Nettie
brought for my dinner some boiled corn beef, a fried cake
slice of fruit cake, piece of apple pie & a sauce dish of apple
jelly. & I boiled a dozen potatoes, three not large turnips ditto
Carrots, ditto beets - Made a small loaf of brown bread & steamed
& 15 baking powder biscuit & had good luck. Steamed a small
apple dumpling - Ate the cakes half the pie & jelly that Nettie
brought & a little of the beef, - and two potatoes, a slice of
turnip & two biscuits, of my cooking. Split & brought in a
oven full of wood as yesterday. Read Nahum Habakkuk and
