Mrs Green called to get something to read - let her take a year of Peterson - Gave her the 10ct purse I bought at Titus's store & sent Mrs Simmons a pound sweeting apple that Fanna sent me - Read papers - Will read Malachi this evening which finishes the Old Testament - Have read a few chapters in Matthew & ♀

Thurs 28

Thawing & rainy snow nearly gone again - Warmed much the last of my vegetable soup, a turnip & ate canned currants - &c - Piled up the wood in coal bin that Lute & Bray threw in, so when they bring more there will be room for it - Read in Mrs P's papers & found a good story, and other matter that I liked in Unity - Will read in Matthew this eve - ♀

Fri 29

Snow gone - Cloudy but warm as springtime - Boiled a small piece of the Derby pork - 3 not large turnips, 3 small carrots 12 medium sized potatoes & dumplings - Read as usual, & darned one ragged stocking - have not seen any one to speak with - but am thankful that I am & ♀

Sat 30

Colder & some snow has fallen - not much - Warmed soup for my breakfast - Made hash of the potatoes & pork, Made Graham griddle cakes for supper & warmed some of the hash. Darned part of a stocking - holes were many large - All day I have thought it Friday - Studied psalms in N Y Times & Telegram - Read as yesterday - No one calls. ♀

Sun 31.

Weather similar to yesterday - Sun shone out once - Warm the soup & hash for my breakfast - & had cracker & canned currants for dessert - Made 16 patty pan ginger cakes - 2 mince pies & a currant tart - Darned on the stocking read, played with the kitten - No one calls & I will have pie &c & say good bye 1893 - with thankful ness ♀
