Tues 30

Wintry - so drifted I have not stepped out of doors today - Cut the rest of my pumpkin & have it nicely stewed - Baked the last of my buckwheat in griddle cakes - Darned my purple stockings - needed a good many stitches - Split a little wood - Finished reading Moab Grange & St Paul's Epistle to Corinthians - 5 chapters - & 2 chapters to the Galatians.

Wed 31

Not stormy - nor windy - nor shiny - sleighs & the like passing and repassing - Made a tin of baking powder biscuits - and a small pumpkin pie without milk or eggs - had a small bit of butter - warmed soup & johnny cake - Split a few sticks of wood fine to dry in oven for kindling - Worked among rags a little while - Read Cliffe House by Eliza W. Pierce & other short stories - and the rest of St Paul's Epistle to the Galatians - a Chapter in Uncle Tom's Cabin

February 1894.

Thurs 1

Pleasant & bright in morning but soon clouds arose & snow has been falling most of the day & wind blows chill this evening - Warmed soup &c - Opened a can of red raspberries - it is nice - Remmed a small square of old ticking - part of a pillow tick - for a holder for napkin - Read Miss or Mrs. by Wilkie Collins - several chapters in Uncle Tom's Cabin - & 3 chapters of St Paul's Epistle to the Ephesians - Split for kindlings

Fri 2.

Fair & bright Candlemas Day - Ground Hog will see his shadow so we may expect six weeks more of winter according to the old sign - Warmed soup, & biscuit & canned raspberries for breakfast - & Totman brought 1 qt of milk to me 5 cts - Read in Uncle Tom's Cabin - Cracked milk a biscuit & raspberries & much for supper - Wrote Mrs Samson & Sadie - Read some of Shadows on the Snow by B. L. Fargson - Mrs Eliza Cummings called a little while - Finished to the Ephesians.

Sat 3

Cloudy but not so cold - I travelled paths from back & front

and a slice of plum jelly cake - Julia was over & finished
