April - 1894

Sun 1.

Spring like not much sunshine - Mrs. K. did give me a small quantity of batter part buckwheat, part flour & that is the last she'll have of buckwheat - & she gave me a piece of cheese three oz maybe. I made a small loaf of corn & fine flour bread steamed it. Boiled 20 potatoes some of them very small, mashed them fried 2 little slices of pork. Cut some briars for kindling. Wrote Mrs Samson - Bought 1 lb 3 oz bread meal risings - I do not like meal risings as well as flour - Mrs Eugene Nickerson died last night at midnight & was buried this P.M. - She had La Grippe & it ended by blood poison we hear - Mrs K. & I went up in the lot so we could see where she was buried - I am sorry she had to die & leave her small boy. Read papers. Cut a few rug sags. ♀

Mon 2

Sunshine but freezing cold. Fried a slice of pork, some pudding and some of the mashed potatoes. Had my washing done with Mrs K's Mr K run the machine & ringer & I hung out most of the white clothes - I had a good doz pieces & I ironed all that needed ironing but one chimney & table cloth. Talla trying to catch Peri in her cage but did not hit her. I slapped Tal but she will get my birds if she can. I shall watch with all the care I can & try to keep the birdies from her. Rover caught a little girl by the arm & bit her not enough to break the skin - Mr K. pounced the poor doggie & swore he would kill him - but I guess that Rover meant play. Went to Totman's got 2 doz eggs 24 cts 25 cts cash and Mrs Perry Totman brought me a qt of milk 5 cts & I had bread & milk for my supper. So did Talla. Read some Mr K. brought Farm & Home & Censor to me from P.O. ♀

Tues 3

Not as cold, & a nice day. Made a cup custard steamed a 3 egg omelet fried, boiled 3 eggs fried pudding &c Mrs K. gave me a slice of ham to fry for my supper and a slice of plum jelly cake. Julia was over & fine
