Tues 17

Pleasant - Mrs K. gave me some creamy buttermilk and I made some good corn meal & flour griddle cakes & fried an egg for my breakfast & had bread, sauce, cold soup, & horse radish, for supper - Mr K gave me a nice cup of coffee at noon - We did our washing & ironing. I had chimneys under wash drawers for stockings - two feet, a holder, apron, sun bonnet, two towels, table spread - & three small white pieces - Reading The Curse of Carew by Lora Thorne's author - Mr K. & Jim made a garden south of old barn - sowed peas & beet. and put in onion sets -

Weds 18

Pleasant - Made scrambled egg - beaten with milk - D Totman brought a qt of milk - Picked over my potatoes. had 6 baskets of good size & about a bushel of little ones. Ruby and Fanna came to see me & I got a cup of tea, bread & butter borrowed of Mrs K., ginger cookies. Sweet apple & quince sauce, black currants, & a piece of grape pie divided in 3 that Mrs K. gave me - She let me have 7 cookies. had some of my molasses & ginger to make the batch. Fanna brought for me 1 qt sweet milk 2 qts buttermilk, & a pt of buckley molasses she said - Mrs K. gave me 1/2 a pt of sweet skim milk before the qts came & I was thankful - Mr & Jim Kierstead worked part of the day plowing & gardening - Read

Thurs 19

Rainy - hear it thunder this evening - Boiled potatoes and mashed them - Steamed an egg beaten with milk & bread Used Mrs K's fire - did not build a fire today Grated two tumblers of horse radish, gave one to Mr K. Swept my bed room - Knit on Mrs K's rug. Shred
