greens boiled with a bacon bone & potatoes - she gave
me some of the potatoes & bacon too - so I will have
some hash with what remains of that & my potatoes

Mon 23

Foggy. Misty - unpleasant - Had a fire, made hash
& steamed bread &c - Knit some on Mrs K's rug - Read
her daily & stories - Marshall & Claude Payne came with
mortar to patch the plastering where it needed.
Charity & Myra Tolman called - Poor Tally is a
silly little cat! - Plan to sleep up stairs because of
the plaster in my bed room f

Tues 24

Pleasant - Mrs K. gave me some graham griddle cake
batter & a piece of fried ham with gravy - I fried an
egg &c - Bought 1 lb 8 oz bread - 8 cts - of Mrs K. Payne
finished the plastering - Julia came & we cleared up
the plaster - "We applied swind" - I knit on rug & am
done with my part & my fingers ache with such
