Pleasant & nice - I went down town with Ellen & got \$12.00 at P.O. on the Orders Fred sent me for Interest on Mortgage - Bought at Mixers 14 yds striped dark blue & white calico 5 ct pr yd. two spools of thread & two pieces of invisible netting for the hair 90 ct, and at a variety store a can of Condensed milk, 20 ct, & a china tea cup & saucer 72 ct - The cup & saucer to be a present to Ellen on her birth day, and wedding anniversary which is tomorrow - Emory for the first time for months had on his pants & sat out on the front veranda three hours more or less, & enjoyed it very much. I walked in with Ellen's help - Ellen & I called at H.C. Luke's a few minutes in early evening -
