Very warm - Did not have a fire - Picked another $\frac{1}{2}$ pt of berries after they were hulled - Picked a handful of flowers & took them to Mrs. B. & P. & gathered a tumbler & sauce dish bouquet for myself - Mrs. Lee has gone over on the Island - Lily Dale - to work - Agnes called a few minutes, she went to the Depot to meet Mrs. Bumpus & Ruby, but Ruby went to Rochester instead of going home - Read the Golden Dawn by Author of Lorna Doone - Mr. K. borrowed my grape basket to send eggs in to village & came to my pump for water - Putting don't pay - See!

Sun 24.

Warm & sunny morning, thunder shower afternoon - Too hot to build a fire. Made 2 bouquets & took one to Jennie Payne the other to Charity Totman in remembrance of their friendship for Aunt Clara - Bought at Totman's 2 qts of milk 8 cts, piece of bread 5 cts $7\frac{3}{4}$ lbs brown sugar 27 cts & Mr. T. gave me a 25 cts cash toward the hay - Saw a little snake in the road - a well enemy - maybe. Found a 4 leaf clover, gave it to Jennie P. for good luck - Imogene gave me a friendly salutation as I passed - Mrs. K. gave me 7 nice ginger cookies & invited me to ride over to Lily Dale I thought it would be nice to go so I got ready & we went to Jennie's & spent a few hours pleasantly - Jennie, Julia Mary Miller sang & played. & I was happily entertained We went to the auditorium at 5 o'clock to a conference meeting Mrs. R. S. Lillie was chief speaker - I enjoyed the out & am glad I went - Mrs. Lee called & I gave her $\frac{1}{2}$ a doz of my cookies & wrote two receipts for cookies for her - & told her she could have flowers to take to the sick woman where she works.

Mon 25.

Pleasant - rather warm - hear thunder in the distance, now near 5 o'clock - Helped tie 43 bunches of onions six in a bunch to sell on the Island - or Lily Dale - Mr. K. got granulated sugar for my part of the onions 9 lbs. (45 cts) & I am happy over it - We picked some of the cherries & I guess that I have enough for a qt. can - Picked a pint cupful of small field strawberries & hulled them - Got 4 small heads of lettuce, gave Birdie a little & ate the rest. Called awhile upon Mrs. Greene & she let me have 4 Buffalo crows - Pulled some weeds.

Tues 26.

Warm - Hard thunder shower this afternoon - just before I came I picked $\frac{1}{2}$ a pt strawberries & a pt of gooseberries - Called on Mrs. Simmons - Greene & Cummings - & bought at Young's a piece of cheese 7 cts. $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon oil 3 cts & 4 lbs sugar 20 cts - Jennie Brooks
