= Very warm - Boiled 10 potatoes & a cup of rice before it was boiled on Mrs K's stove - Gave her a cupful of the cooked & she gave me a wedge of short cake - I picked enough strawberries for a sauce dish of sauce - Read in "Stand Off & grape berries" "Little Lee" brought Unlly to me from P.O. Mrs Cummings called me evening & I went a piece with her - Feel blue & stupid - Tolla has four kittens in Mrs K's box down cellar & I don't know what to do with them - 2 black 2 grey -

Sun 1st

July 1894 -

= Warmer if possible than yesterday - Made a butter gravy broke two eggs in it & warmed up potatoes & poured all over some of the dry short cake that I baked the other day - Used Mrs K's fire - I helped her shell a few peas, without her saying I might, & she cooked them for dinner with potatoes & she gave me 3 small potatoes & plenty of peas & I seasoned them - Mrs Green made me a pleasant call and Ma Lee came to say she had no money for rent as yet - Finished reading "Stand Off" - Wrote Mrs Samson

Mon 2

= Very warm - Made corn meal mush on Mrs K's stove - Sent my letter to office by Mr K - Sewed on old sheets - have two whole but they are not strong - have two more to mend - Set out 42 a doz small tomato plants - picked 50 currants for my supper Made up a tumbler bouquet for Mrs Green, & one for myself & a sauce dish of roses, pansies & pinks for me - They are very pretty - Chatted quite a while with Mrs Simmons - Now at near 6 o'clock a nice little thunder shower - Read in The Fortune Teller of St O

Tues 3

Almost as warm as yesterday - Boiled ten potatoes & an egg - Opened can of dried beef & made gravy - with egg stirred in used Mrs K's fire - Picked a bouquet for Jessie Payne and went & tried my dress on - Called on Mrs Greene & shelled a small mess of peas for her - Went to Tolmans & got a qt of milk 4cts & a doz eggs 12c - For supper scrambled an egg in milk, on Mrs K's stove - Finished Fortune Teller of St. O. by Peck & began Larnel Leronda by George Elliott Knit on rug, & sewed awhile on old sheet - Picked 296 currants - Mrs K - ditto & it is all there is -

Wed 4

Not quite as warm - Used Mrs K's fire to bake a little tin of biscuit & warm some potatoe - & dish water - The K's all went away to spend the day & left me in the enjoyment of
