Rain in morning early - Clouds & sunshine through the day
Warmed my potato & pork again. ate the last of the cake.
Mrs S. gave me - finished reading D.L.B. - Went over to the
S.s and rubbed up the stove, mopped the kitchen, pantry &
sink room floors, made bed, pared ten potatoes - Came home
& read in Peoples Home Journal -

Wed 25

Clouds & sunshine - Mrs K. gave me a saucer of cooked peas &
I picked 2 lbs of red raspberries for me, & 1 lb for Mrs K. She is to
have another lb picked another day - Went to Simmons - Swept
a little with carpet sweeper, washed dishes, pared 10 potatoes
made bed - Read a little in P.H.J.

Thurs 26

Very warm - Mrs K. gave me warmed potato & a cup of tea
for my breakfast & I picked a basket of peas helped shell them
& scraped 1/2 a doz little potatoes & had enough of them after they
were cooked for dinner & supper - Canned my 2 lbs rasp
berries - had 1 lb & mustard ring full after they were cooked
with 2 cups granulated sugar - Went over to Simmons
pared potatoes & made bed - My Willie's bird not well
cleaned his cage, gave him chick weed, cayenne, dandelion
&c - took him out on the ground &c - Read short stories
Bought 1 pt milk of Mrs K.

Fri 27

Pleasant - Mrs. K. & I got ready, & Mr K. drove us over to Lily
Dale - I paid 15 cts entrance fee to the Camp for myself, and
went with Mrs K. to see song firm's - and Julia prepared a good
dinner of which I partook - We attended exercises of the
Lyceum, speaking, singing, marching, &c - which interested me
ever so much - This was in the morning before dinner - afternoon
we listened to a good lecture delivered by Carrie E. S. Twining - &
Mr. F. Cordozo White gave "platform tests" if that is what they
are called - I never get any public tests, & no others that are
positive proofs of immortality - yet I believe - We came home
on the boat, each paying 5 cts for our ride - Mr K met us not
far from the boat - Mr. E. Evans & Mr. S. Cleland Evans & she
told me that John W. Cleland was dead -
