Thurs 16.

Pleasant - Canned a qt of blackberries. boiled a few small potatoes - made a few griddle cakes, fried a cucumber and some cold boiled potatoes & a slice of bread. Mrs K. boiled two potatoes & 2 ears of corn for me - with her dinner - I wish they would divide the potatoes & corn by rows & let me have my share & cook or sell as I can. I do so awfully dislike the old she. Mrs Bouquin called to see if I had any pears to sell, & H. Tolman paid 31cts - and he owes only 2cts now. I am sleepy & low spirited don't know why. My other little grey kitten is not well, and no one comes for the black ones. maybe that is some of the cause for my low spirits. Went to P.O. & Youngs & sent \$1.00 to pay for Grape Belt - Bought 5 stamps 10c. $\frac{1}{4}$ lb Tea. 2oz gun powder 2oz Japan. Can dried beef 20c. package corn starch. Got a basket of bark at milk yard. Mrs K. gave kits 2 gills of sweet skim milk. little grey seems better & I am not sleepy & feel in better spirits. lent Mrs Lee my gallon butter crock. ♀

Fri 17

Pleasant - Made a cottage pudding cake & a ginger cake & Mrs K. made me a loaf of bread. $1\frac{3}{4}$ lbs meal risings & I said I would give her credit on rent 10cts. Bought $\frac{1}{2}$ a pint of milk of her 1ch - for kits. Mr K picked pears on the limb that was broken & my part was 40 pears. Mrs Lee gave me a pint of blackberry sauce. I returned Daniel Alronde and borrowed 10 Nights in a Bar Room by T S Arthur. History of the Johnstown Flood by Willis Fletcher Johnson & One Night's Mystery - by M.A. Flemming - Picked a few hemp seed. Mrs Lee borrowed new shears. Mrs Bouquin called a little while to be neighborly - Mrs K. is agreeable today. ♀

Sat 18.

Pleasant - dry and dusty. Got ready, went over to Mrs Cummings and we took the train for Lily Dale. Car fare 10cts. gate fee 15cts. Bought at Wilcox.
