Pleasant - Steamed potatoes, fried pork & bread, made gravy & tea. Mrs G. with me to breakfast & then she went over to Simmons to dinner & came back & supped with me then went to Simmons for the night - Mrs K. borrowed my room up stairs, her father & sister came to remain awhile - & I will sleep in my down stairs bed room
