Wed 22

Pleasant - Bought a pt of milk 2cts & $\frac{1}{2}$ a doz eggs 8cts of Mrs K. - Got ready near 9 o'clock & walked over to Lily Dale most of the way on the R.R. track - Sophie wasn't at the Depot & I could not find her, & the surmise is she did not leave home. Saw Mrs & Mr Lee of Fredonia & she introduced me to Mrs & Mr Miller & they said Sophie & Mrs J. were not at Fredonia Station to take the train - Tore my silk skirt & grasshoppers ate two holes in it as large as my finger nail - Visited with Melissa Penhollow & Electa Ivin - spoke with Mrs Cardot - Eliza & Eliza Cummings Mrs Green. Amelia Warren - Wm & Henry Penhollow. Mary Miller Bought at Wilson Bread, rolls, cheese, cookies, & a qt of plums all amounted to 40cts. Entrance fee 15cts - Walked home thereby saving 10cts - Heard Miss Anthony & Rev Anna Shaw & did not think their talk elevating nor immensely entertaining Band music & singing good - Eat & read -
Hear that Mrs Byron Alford is dead

Pleasant - Built a fire, got $\frac{1}{2}$ a doz ears of corn in field boiled a few potatoes & steamed the corn - Canned the bitter blackberries, a qt - Stewed my qt of plums for sauce & some apples - made some dry bread in stuffing - Mrs Green called to say she was going to Dunkirk - Mrs Ella May Lee came to borrow pen & ink - Mrs K gave me a fricaseed chickens back & neck & liver, with gravy & a biscuit, with a saucer of blackberries She had her father, sister, Jim & Julia, Bertie & Lee & Mary Miller to supper. & was not feeling well, so I coaxed her to let me wipe the pile of dishes - Read in my story -
