Very foggy A.M. smoky & dusty P.M. Cooked a few pears to dry. - Cut corn from cobs & boiled yesterday, prepared some to eat & some to dry. Read Crimson Stain to the end & began Peck's Sunshine & Thrilling Scenes among the Indians. - Went to P.O. got Grape Belt & a Hammonston paper from Ida, & read them. - Bought at Youngs 4 lbs of Coffee & Sugar 20 cts. 1/2 lb Crackers 4 cts & Winter green lozenges 5 cts. Went to Mrs. Cummings & stayed to tea. - took a note for Uesta to Jennie Payne. - paid Jennie the 50 cts for making my under waists. - Mr. Kierstead dug 8 rows of potatoes (7 bushels) only part 3 1/2 bushels, good ones to look to (large & small). - Mrs. K. & I picked them in pails from the wagon & Mr. K. measured & divided them & put them in cellar. - Mrs. Lee, Mrs. Bouguin & Mrs. K. called on me.

Not much change in weather. - Gathered all the corn on 15 hills. boiled some, steamed some, & cut some from the cob to cook & dry in a pan over boiling water. - Mrs. K. told me how to split some husks toward pillows. - Helped with the potatoes as yesterday - about 4 bushels for me to add to the 3 1/2 and there are a few more to dig. - Mrs. K. gave me a nice warm biscuit with butter - a piece of Custard pie & 2 plums & Talla a pancake. - She & Mrs. Bouguin called this evening. - Mrs. Lee came to borrow my Camphor for toothache. - Read &

Sun 2

Very warm. - Bought 1 pt milk of Mrs. K. Boiled Corn potatoes - made & steamed a cup custard, & scrambled an egg in milk with cut corn. fried 2 slices pork & an egg - made gravy. - mopped kitchen & c. Read in Peck's Sunshine & Indian Book. - Mrs. Bouguin called & returned my Kansas Receipt Book.
