Thurs 13

Rainy - rather cool - Made a pork stew adding onions, potatoes & dumplings - Made a small teacupful of sour milk into griddle cake - Stewed an apple for sauce - Ella Lee brought me a piece of layer cake with frosting & Candy Trimming - it would have been particularly good if she had used good butter - She borrowed my umbrella & then 2 plates - The Reed's visited her - I have finished reading "The D. T." - Hear that Dr Chauncey Rood has sold his Cassadaga home & that his Uncle by marriage, Chauncey Abbey is dead - Husked a few ears of corn & pounded my fingers driving a nail to fix a place to hang corn to dry - ♀

Fri 14

Pleasant - Stewed a few apples for sauce - Pared 8 or 10 & spread them on plates to dry - Warmed my stew - Called at Simmons - Worked at my corn - Fingers all right - Mrs K. gave me a plate of Chicken pot pie for my supper & it was good
