Very pleasant - Warmd potatoe & made butter gravy for tho 2 griddle cakes Mrs K. gave me for my breakfast & I had a cup of sage tea - Made a shirt in jelly & cooked oat meal for supper & Mrs K gave me a small slice of cake & a cup of tea - Henry Penhollow & wife came with paper hanger Evans & assistant & the shop is cleaned & front room papered, my extension table spread with millinery goods & Lutes stove set up in back room - & I am pleased with the improvements & hope all will be as it should be in the end - Let Mrs P. have gold dust & soap to clean with - Mrs Bouguin called - Finished reading Prettiest of all & read in R M A. - Mapped my kitchen - Knit 3 shells, or scallops

Thurs 18

Very pleasant - Warmd oat meal for breakfast & Mrs K. gave me tea & it had steeped so long it was not good but made a nice looking fortune - Cooked six small green tomatoes with cracker for my dinner & bought 1/2 lb yeast bread of Mrs K. 2 1/2 ct - Mapped privy floor & back room where my stove stood - Called twice at Milliner's shop, with Mrs K. & Mrs Bouguin - Papering looks good - Mrs Penhollow wanted I should give her the old stove that Emory gave A W. so I did & I want a goods box of hers, & she said I could have it when she was through with it - Offered Mrs K. my cake pan so she should use it & keep it from rusting - Knit 12 shells

Fri 19

Very pleasant - Boiled a doz, not large, potatoes & made pork gravy. Mr K divided the small beans & my share was a peck. - some poor ones - Ella Lee returned my Arnicar & wanted to borrow my colander. I did not care to lend it, but let her take a pan that had 2 small holes in, to perforate with shingle nail holes, to sift her grapes through - I told her to return it - I would be willing she should keep it if she would keep away I do not like to lend to her, she does not return things when she says she will, &c - Washed 2 pr best sheets, 2 pr pillow cases, A W's bed spread, chimise, apron, socks, 4 towels flannel petticoat & 1/2 doz dust rags.
