Mon 22

Another nice day. Cooked six little green tomatoes with a cracker seasoned with salt & sugar. Fried the last bit of the Simmons pork. made gravy, fried cold mashed potatoes. Ate of my ginger bread & I have dyspeptic turn. Mailed the letter I wrote Mrs Samson & got a basket of bark & some in my arms. & it was too heavy & I feel the worse for it. Mrs Simmons rode over to the Christian Meeting House Cemetery today to see Little Johnnies grave & Monument. Chester Simmons & John set her chair & all in the carriage &c. Read in R. M. A. Knit on stocking & 12 shells. Ironed pr sheets, pr pillow cases, flannel pelle coat. ♀
