Mrs K. went over to Jim's & found him no better - Mrs
De Lisle came home with her, to stay with me. I got
corn meal mush & milk for supper & bread & butter.
Bought 2 1/2 cts bread & 2 1/2 cts milk of Mrs K. and she
spent part of the evening here, with Mrs L. & me.
The Hord's moved today - flocks & herds, bag & baggage
- made me think of Jacob's removal, &c.

Thurs 22

Pleasant & not cold. Buckwheat cakes, bread & butter
honey & tea for breakfast - Mrs De Lisle returned to Lily
Hale about 11 o'clock - Mrs K. went & spent the day at Jim's
He seemed a little better she said. She took my spring
couch over for his comfort, & her easy chair, & he was
