Thurs 20

Pleasant - Made buckwheat cakes for breakfast & onion
potato turnip rice soup with the pigs leg. Mrs Penhollow
came & tried a bonnet frame on my head & took my
velvet ~~over~~ high lips & ribbon from my summer bonnet
& she is to make me a winter bonnet - Mr K. paid me
the \$5.00 for my hay. Read in the Royal Path of Life -
& in Unity, Grape Belt. & Home Guest which Mr K. brought
to me from P. Q. Mrs Bouguin came as last evening & we
knit on our rugs - & I will knit a scallop of lace & go to bed

Fri 21

Breezy, otherwise pleasant & Mr. Sprinkled P.M. Warmd soup
for breakfast & supper - Bought 1 lb 9 oz chuse 20 cts & 1/2 a doz
fried cakes 5 cts of Mrs Simmons - Went to Mr Hills & paid my
tax \$7.31 - Called at Harrington's store & bought 1 lb crackers
7 cts - 2 packages of paper 20 cts - 2 fruit plates 40 cts & a fancy
dish 40 cts - Mrs Simmons gave me a piece of baked pork
because she thought it would spoil before they could eat it
Mrs Bouguin gave me a stick of hoarhound candy & a large
orange, for a Christmas present & I gave her a fruit plate
I bought it for her - She paid the \$3.00 that she borrowed
