Wed 9

Met Miss Kollmeyer there. Mrs S. sent me $\frac{1}{2}$ a doz. apples & 2 or more qts soft soap by Mrs Bouquin, because I did this ironing. Mrs B came this evening & knit on her rug until 8 o'clock as usual. She was a little better. I knit 3 scallops lace ♀

Thurs 10.

Rainy & thawing. Made a soup of broth, potatoes, spoon of rice & three small dumplings. Mrs K. gave me a cup of tea $\frac{1}{2}$ of a gilliflower - a red pepper for birdies. Willie got hung by his toes & I caught him to see about the nails. They look as if he had shed the old ones & little tender new ones had come to replace them. He was scared to have me take him. Washed some dish towels & a pr of stockings. Ironed my Satten skirt. Mrs Bouquin ^{& Kollmeyer} spent an hour & a half chatting in my room. Knit 1 scallop lace. Read in T. R. P. of L. ♀

Fri 11

Some snow squally. Pleasant moonlit evening, breezy. Made an onion soup with some of my broth & bones. Mrs K. gave me a cup of skim milk - and a cup of tea - when I went for my cup I dropped my oldest glass creamer & broke half of the bottom off. Had better refused the tea - ought to. Made some poor graham griddle cakes, & some good molasses to eat with them. Willie sick in A.M. but better this evening. Knit 8 rounds on rug & 1 scallop lace. Read in R. P. of L. & Mrs Bouquin came this evening & I read papers to her. Mina sent S. J. R. with Sadie's obituary notice. ♀

Sat 12

Thaws a little. sunshine, but more clouds. Warm soup & make Corn meal mush. Mrs K. gave me a cup of skim milk $2\frac{1}{4}$ apples. & a mince turnover. Wrote Agnes Cross. Bertie brought Unity & Grape belt. Wrote Homer & family. Mrs K. gave me a very nice biscuit & butter for my supper. Mrs Bouquin came as usual with her rug to knit & stayed until 8 o'clock. She had been to the village & got a Woods Calendar for me, very pretty. Heart shape & two handsome faces of little girls. Read items to her & stories & sermon of Talmadge to myself. ♀
Knit 3 scallops of lace. Willie about as last night.
