Read in History & read stories & poems to Mrs. B. then eve called over to Simmons & Mrs. S. & B. gave me 5 apples & Mr. S. brought from P.B. Unity & a letter from Mary B. Miller & a sheet written for her Grandmother enclosed. I gave it to the old person & she said thanks & that was all the communion between us. Disagreeable ♀

Wed 13

Weather similar to yesterday. Fried a slice of pork & made Johnny cake. They had a surprise party for John King's last night & sent some of the bits of cake to Mrs Simmons & she wished to divide with me, so Mrs Bouquin brought them this morning. (2 kinds frosted) Mrs K. said good morning! & I said good morning. Mr K. said he had put up my wood for March sent, & wished I would let him give me wood for the Feb. & he owes & I said he might, so I must endure until April 1st & if they will go then O K. Read in History & worked on calico a little while. Bought a News let, & read that and Grape Bell to Mrs Bouquin this evening. ♀

Thurs 14

A good many degrees colder. Sunshine through the day, but I guess zero will be reached before it is warmer. Made 2 dried apple pies & some hard ginger bread drop cakes. Stewed a pt of beans (kidney) made a bowl of corn meal mush, melted a little sugar. Began some of Saphie's Edging with 10 30 coats cotton. Knit 6 scallops. Cut a few calicoes. Read in H of Animals. Mrs K. glumly said good morning as I passed from my bed room to kitchen & I responded. Did not see the old man - nor Lee. Read to Mrs Bouquin this evening. ♀

Fri 15

Water froze in house &c. Warmer P.M. & snowed some
