II. Be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

"EXHIBIT F."

An Act to authorize a requisition to be made for the payment of a portion of the amount that may be appropriated by Congress for payment to the Muscogee Nation, under the agreement of January 19th, A. D. 1889, for its interest in and to the lands ceded to the United States by the treaty of 1866.

I. Be it enacted by the National Council of the Muscogee Nation, That the Principal Chief of the Muskogee Nation be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Muscogee Nation, to make requisition upon the proper authorities of the United States, in such form as may be required by such authorities, for the payment to Pleasant Porter, David M. Hodge, and Es-par-he-cher, the duly authorized delegates of the Muscogee Nation, or in the event of the death or inability to act of any or either of them, then to the surviving member or members of
