

them, of the sum of 10 per cent. of the additional price of the lands ceded to the United States by the treaty of 1866, under the agreement of January 19th, A. D. 1889, between Honorable William F. Vilas, Secretary of the Interior, and said delegates, the same to be paid out of the amount that may be appropriated by Congress to be paid in money to the Muscogee Nation on account of the purchase of said lands; the same to be paid in such sums and at such times and places as shall be requested by said delegates, and said requisition, when made, shall be taken and accepted as, and is hereby declared to be, the requisition of the proper authorities of the Muscogee Nation.

II. *Be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
