

ent periods, will not, we think, make any difference in the claim for \$5,696.62, the balance before mentioned. If the Osages were entitled to credit for filing fees in 1886, their claim for such amounts as were then remaining, and have been since received, is equally good, there having been no new laws passed or decisions made bearing on the subject.
