

upon as the price of said lands, that is to say, the amount to be invested for the benefit of the Muscogee Nation, and the amount to be paid in money directly to the proper authorities of the said Muscogee Nation, and the said amount which is to be paid in money to be paid over in such sums and at such times and places as may be required directly to the National Treasurer of the Muscogee Nation, or to such officer or other person or persons as shall be *named* in the requisition of the proper authorities of the Muscogee Nation; and the proper authorities of the Muscogee Nation, for the purpose of making such requisition or requisitions, is hereby declared to be the National Council of the Muscogee Nation, or such officer or other person or persons as shall be designated and authorized by an act or resolution of the said National Council for that purpose; and such requisition or requisitions, when made, shall be taken and accepted as, and is and are, hereby declared to be the requisition of the proper authorities of the Muscogee Nation.

II. *Be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
