As I failed to mail my letter this morning I will add a bit more to it.

Received the word at our Radio Station late last night that Austria-Hungary is trying to accept Pres. Wilson's peace terms. Also rumored this evening that "Kaiser Bill" and his gang are thinking seriously of quitting their post. U. S. now means more than United States, "unconditional surrender."

A Masonic friend with our Red Cross detachment and I walked down to our "rear echelon," which has moved up with in 7 kilometers of us. My mission was to get more new clothing, as you might know. Sure have some fine light weight woolen underwear, had drawn some extra heavy wear, but the weather here now is far warmer than in southern Kansas at this time. While down below, I met Harlow and Arthur Snow, all the boys are quite well and are located in a beautiful little camp. Was
