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TOUR DE NICODEMUS 2ND ANNUAL BIKE TOUR

JULY 31 - AUGUST 2

LAST YEAR'S NICODEMUS BIKE TOUR WAS SO POPULAR THAT IT'S BACK BY "POPULAR DEMAND."

WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT NICODEMUS, KANSAS? FEWER THAN 40 PEOPLE LIVE IN THIS ALL BLACK TOWN WHICH WAS FOUNDED IN 1877. BUT, 400-500 PEOPLE WHO STILL CONSIDER "DEMUS" HOME, COME EACH YEAR FOR "HOMECOMING" THE LAST WEEKEND IN JULY. THESE PEOPLE, YOUNG AND OLD, ARE ANXIOUS TO SHARE THEIR HERITAGE WITH VISITORS. SOME WILL EVEN CYCLE WITH US.

NICODEMUS IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSIDERATION BY CONGRESS FOR NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE STATUS.

IT'S SUCH A LONG CAR TRIP (5 HOURS), WE'VE DECIDED TO DIVIDE IT INTO TWO TOURS. FRIDAY NIGHT WE'LL STOP IN COUNCIL GROVE, TWO HOURS FROM K.C., AND STAY IN EITHER OF TWO BED & BREAKFASTS OR CAMP AT THE RESERVOIR. SATURDAY WE'LL CYCLE THROUGH THE FLINT HILLS TO STRONG CITY AND BACK. THEN, WE'LL DRIVE THREE HOURS TO HILL CITY/NICODEMUS. THIS TIME, YOUR CHOICE OF A MOTEL OR CAMPING AT WEBSTER RESERVOIR.

WE HAVE RESERVED 12 ROOMS IN BOTH COUNCIL GROVE AND HILL CITY. THESE WILL BE ON A FIRST COME BASIS.

THE COTTON WOOD FALLS TOUR IS ABOUT 40 MILES. THE NICODEMUS TOUR IS 62 MILES WITH SEVERAL SHORTER ROUTES.
