LAST YEAR'S NICODEMUS BIKE TOUR WAS SO POPULAR THAT IT'S BACK BY "POPULAR DEMAND."

WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT NICODEMUS, KANSAS? FEWER THAN 40 PEOPLE LIVE IN THIS ALL BLACK TOWN WHICH WAS FOUNDED IN 1877. BUT, 400-500 PEOPLE WHO STILL CONSIDER "DEMUS" HOME, COME EACH YEAR FOR "HOMECOMING" THE LAST WEEKEND IN JULY. THESE PEOPLE, YOUNG AND OLD, ARE ANXIOUS TO SHARE THEIR HERITAGE WITH VISITORS. SOME WILL EVEN CYCLE WITH US.

NICODEMUS IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSIDERATION BY CONGRESS FOR NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE STATUS.

IT'S SUCH A LONG CAR TRIP (5 HOURS), WE'VE DECIDED TO DIVIDE IT INTO TWO TOURS.
