

Homemaker's Craft Camp

The Graham County Home Economics Advisory Committee is willing to pay the camp fee of two county homemakers who are interested in attending the craft camp and will come back and teach others in the county what they learned. The Craft Camp is August 5 and 6, Monday and Tuesday at Camp Webster near Salina. As many ladies from the county may attend as wish to, but expense of only two will be paid by the advisory committee.

The camp fee for both days is \$7.00. This includes meals and lodging. If you wish to attend only one day the first day is \$2.75 and the second day \$2.50.

Some of the crafts offered will include ceramics, plastic molds for garden decorations, stationery made from waxed paper and Kleenex, chair caning, beginners knitting, wheat corsages and centerpieces, and smocked hats and pillows.

Please have your name and camp fee in to the county extension office by July 24 if you plan to attend the Craft Camp.
