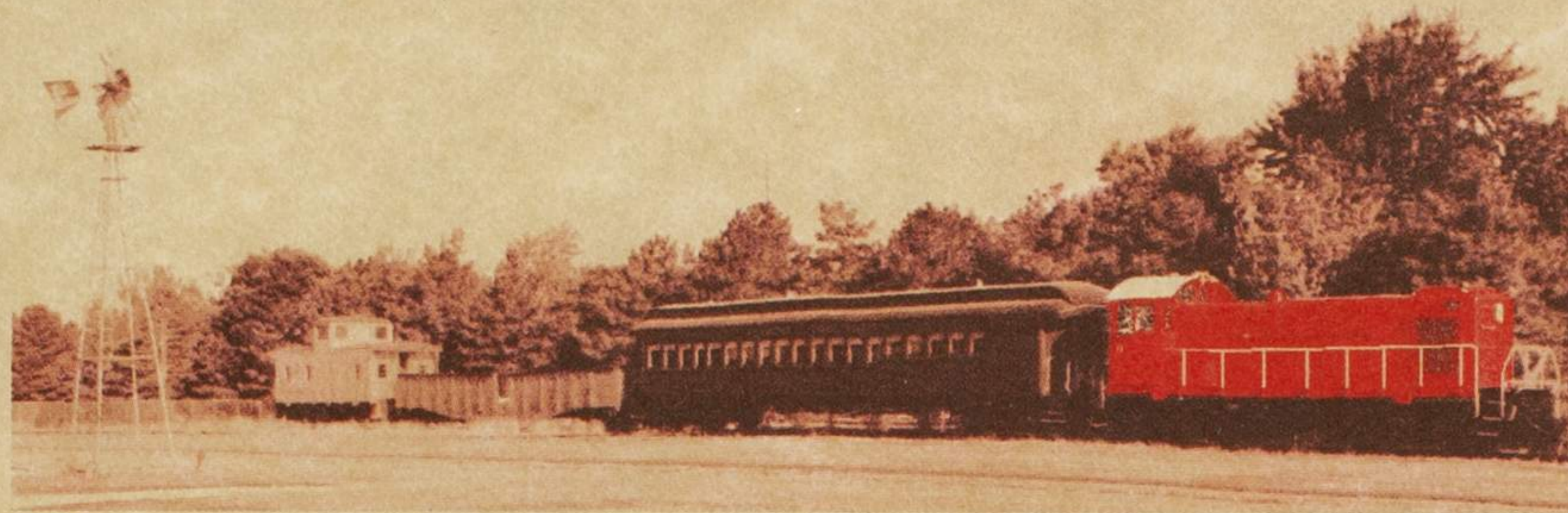


**T**he Abilene & Smoky Valley Railroad runs 6 miles through fertile Kansas farmland. Experience the pleasures of early day

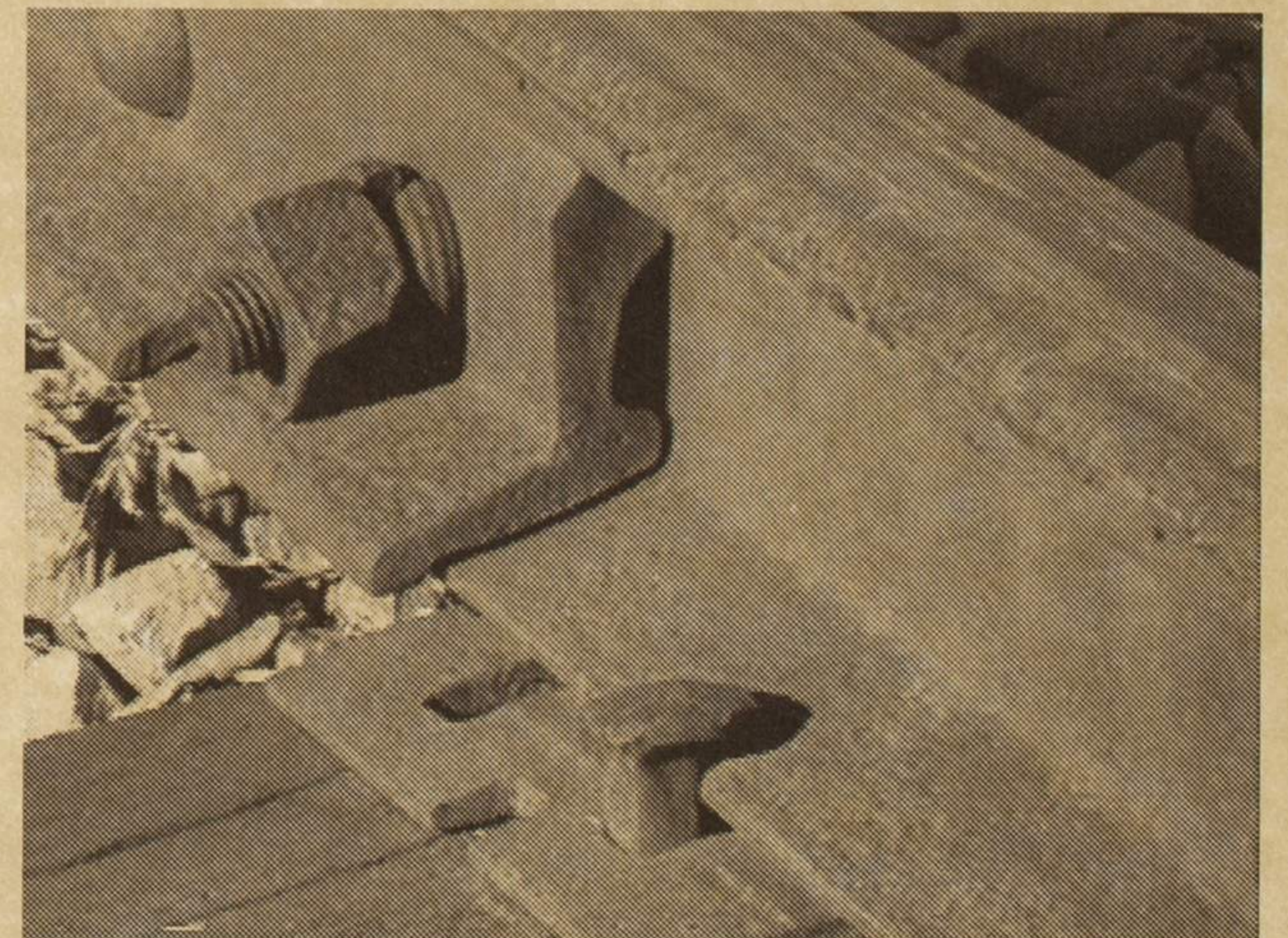
