Instructions for Authors

Because most issues are devoted to a central theme, prospective authors are urged to inquire as to the suitability of potential articles. Please outline via letter the subject proposed.

When submitting articles, they must be original and offered exclusively to **JOURNAL of the WEST.** The **author** is **responsible** for **obtaining written permissions** required for both quotations and illustrations used as well as costs incurred. In seeking illustrations, the author should mention that the **JOURNAL of the WEST** is an IRS approved 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

The author should retain a copy of the article as submitted. The manuscript should be typed double-spaced, on one side of $8\frac{1}{2}x11$ -inch paper, with ample margins.

Ideal maximum length is 15 pages, including bibliographic note, to follow the essay. End notes if absolutely necessary, should be used for direct quotations only.

The JOURNAL of the WEST is aimed at the knowledgeable Western History Enthusiast as well as the academic. Articles should be based on sound scholarly research, though directed to a less formal audience.

Please attach to any submission photocopies of illustrations, with the caption typed on the photocopy, and a brief biographical sketch.

Upon acceptance of the submission, photographs and illustrations should be supplied as black and white glossies, which the publisher will return.

The submission of an article, book review, or other communication, with the intention that it be published in the journal, shall be taken as *prima-facie* evidence that the author willingly transfers the copyright to the journal and its parent organization, which will freely grant the author the right to reprint his material in his own works. In the case of articles, upon acceptance for publication, the author will be sent a contract to sign and return.
