SEC. 6. In order that the provisions of this act may be more definitely enforced, it is hereby provided that the enumerators of school children, in taking their annual school census, shall ascertain and record the name, place, and date of birth of every child enumerated, and the parent, guardian or persons having charge or control of such child shall subscribe and take oath or affirmation that such record is true. The enumerator is hereby empowered to administer such oath or affirmation; and any parent, guardian or person having charge or control of any child who shall refuse to take such oath or affirmation shall be adjudged guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than one nor more than ten dollars. (Revised School Laws of 1919-1920, Sec. 242.)
