On motion, it was voted that J. A. Deprad be nominated for Director of district 87

On motion, it was voted that Lon Alexander be nominated for Treasure of district 87

A motion to nominate Henry Williams for Treasure of district 87 was lost for want of a second.

On motion, it was voted that we suspend the rule and vote for the Nominee's by acclamation.

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On motion, it was voted, unanimously, that L. T. Sayers be clerk of district 87 until July meeting 1908

On motion, it was voted, unanimously, that J. A. Deprad be Director of district 87 until July meeting 1908.

On motion, it was voted, unanimously, that Lon Alexander be Treasure of district 87 until July meeting 1908.

On motion, it was voted that the school house be built on the north side of the section road as near the center of the district as possible.

On motion, it was voted, that the new school house be 24 feet wide and 30 feet long.

On motion, it was voted that the school board find the cost of the following kinds of buildings. Stone, Frame and Cement, and report to the people at the next meeting.

On motion, it was voted that we adjourn subject to the call of the board.
