Dear Tom:

Dr. Carl Voltmer and I had a friendly visit here last Saturday during the time of the Kansas Relays.

I told him that two years previous to the time we played you this last year we came down to Warrensburg for \$100.00. That was at the time Tad Reid was athletic director there. So I felt that your trip back here last year was a return engagement for that game.

We would be willing to play you at Warrensburg on December 8 and 9 for the dedication of your gymnasium for a guarantee of \$150.00, with an option of 50%. I am quite sure the option would not be exercised, but I would like to bring the team down there and stay over night, and would not want to lose money on the trip. I would naturally take a large squad, because it is early in the season. I figure it would take this much money to handle the expenses of the trip.

I would be willing to say that if in the future we would play you a return game here in Lawrence we would give you the same sort of a guarantee.
