Dear Jimmie:

We have finally completed arrangements to play the University of Texas at Austin on December 16 and 17, and we are now in position to have you forward contract to us as per the stipulations set out in your letter of June 4th.

We will meet you in Dallas on December 19 and 20, as I believe these are the dates we agreed upon. Will you kindly make out the contract for \$400.00 for the two games with the option of 60% of the gate receipts if the amount should run higher than the guarantee. I will thank you also to make the contract so that Mr. Gwin Henry, Director of Athletics, can sign for the University of Kansas. If you care to incorporate the reciprocal guarantee feature should you play here this will be very pleasing to me. We would be very happy to meet you here in Lawrence a year from this date, with a reciprocal guarantee and option.

I am wondering if you will discuss with your basketball coach a list of eligible officials for those games. I have written Dana Bible, and wondered if it would be possible to get our old friend, E. C. Quigley, to work both the Texas and S.M.U. games. Maybe you two fellows could get together and get him down there. He is not our conference official, but he has a national reputation in all the major sports, and I think he might be a drawing card. Our conference guarantee is \$20.00 per game and expenses, and by you and D. K. going together the expenses should not be prohibitive. Any men that your Coach Baccus nominates I am sure will be ample to select a pair from.

I am sorry that Billy Dewell will not be playing next year. It would be fine to play S.M.U. with an outstanding Kansas athlete in the line up. This would add interest to the contest.
