This will acknowledge your good favor of December 16th written from a Chicago hospital. I am sorry that it was necessary for you to cancel these games.

With Chili Cochrane going on the coaching staff at Kansas State and with the death of Pat Mason and your resignations I find that my schedule so far as officials is concerned is badly torn up. I trust that you will be able to work after February first.

I trust that your foot is mending rapidly and that all of this rest that you are getting will be helpful to you in many ways. It is a pleasure for me to do anything that I can to help your ailing foot along.

The approaching new year finds my revenue in the usual depleted condition, and while I am always willing to offer my services gratis, I am wondering if you would mind taking care of the actual expenses incurred in driving out to St. Marys. I find it took about ten gallons of gas on the round trip. Figuring the trips that I made, with the oil and gas and the incidental expense of traveling, it would come to about \$8.00 for the trips that I made.

I am just running over a lot of my accounts and find that I have over \$100 out where I have incurred expenses and have failed to get back the money that I have spent for making these trips, and it is in line with this policy that I am trying to clear some of these small obligations so that I will have to pay less interest on my money.

If it is convenient for you I will appreciate your sending me a check to cover my bare expenses.
