Dear Dee:

In my letter of August 12 I promised you that I would write you and give you dates when I returned to Lawrence.

I am corresponding with Don Cooper, of Southwestern. I told him that I would like to play both Southwestern and Washburn in Lawrence the week beginning December 13. Our Christmas vacation begins on the night of the 17th. Therefore, I would like to play you on the 16th, if possible.

However, if I find that Cooper cannot come the first part of the week and if he could only make it the last part of the week, I would like to play you on the 14th. Please reserve the 14th and 16th at Lawrence until I can hear from Don Cooper.

For the game at Topeka, it may be that we can play you on January 4th. I would kindly ask you to hold the date of the 4th until I have word from a team that was planning to play us on the 4th here in Lawrence. They are travelling through and I have no definite word from them as yet. We open here in Lawrence with Oklahoma on January 7th.

I will try to get this information in the course of a week or ten days. We are playing Missouri at Columbia on January 19, so of course the 18th and 19th would be out.

Perhaps if none of these dates for the game in Topeka can be worked out we can get together on some other date. I am sending you our Big Six schedule, and perhaps after looking this over you can plan on some satisfactory date. I am hoping, however, that the 4th will work out at Topeka.
