I am submitting for your consideration the approval of some tentative basketball games that we are desirous of playing:

Dec. 6, Doane College, at Lawrence,
guarantee, \$80
Dec. 7, Ottawa University, at Lawrence,
guarantee, \$35
Dec. 10, Ottawa University, at Ottawa,
guarantee, \$35
Dec. 14, Southwestern College, at Lawrence,
guarantee, \$100
Dec. 16, 17, or 18, Washburn College, at
Topeka, \$200 with option
Dec. 23, Southwestern College, at Winfield,
guarantee, \$300 with option
Dec. 29, Drake University, at Des Moines
guarantee, \$400
Jan. 3 or 4, Washburn College, at Lawrence
guarantee, \$200 with option
Jan. 3 or 4, University of Utah, at Lawrence
guarantee, \$150.

You will observe that all of these games are played either during the Christmas vacation, or are short hauls with Kansas always having the financial advantage. I have viewed it from the standpoint that when the Kansas team plays away from here they are the attraction and should receive more money than the smaller schools would receive here.

Further, the Athletic Board gave permission to play "B" teams in basketball. We are desirous of playing some of these smaller colleges with our "B" team.
