Dear Dick:

Thank you very kindly for your
letter of June 19th.

I was glad to know that you will
be willing to play us in a couple of early season games
in basket ball.

We have a game scheduled here for
December 6th with Doane College of Crete, Nebraska. The
coach up there is a brother of Ward Haylett, track coach
at Kansas State College, and they are making a trip
through here early in December.

However, this will not interfere
with our game on the 7th as we will have the auditorium
prepared and we will be glad to meet you here on that date.
The 10th will be satisfactory for the return game at Ottawa.

It does not make a great deal of
difference about the guarantee as it will be a reciprocal
agreement, but I would suggest that we make it \$30 or \$40
which will cover the expenses of the trip. I think it is
better to have a definite guarantee than to have us take
care of our expenses without a guarantee.
