Two large ballrooms, each with hard-wood maple dance floor—one has capacity 150 couples, the other 500 couples.

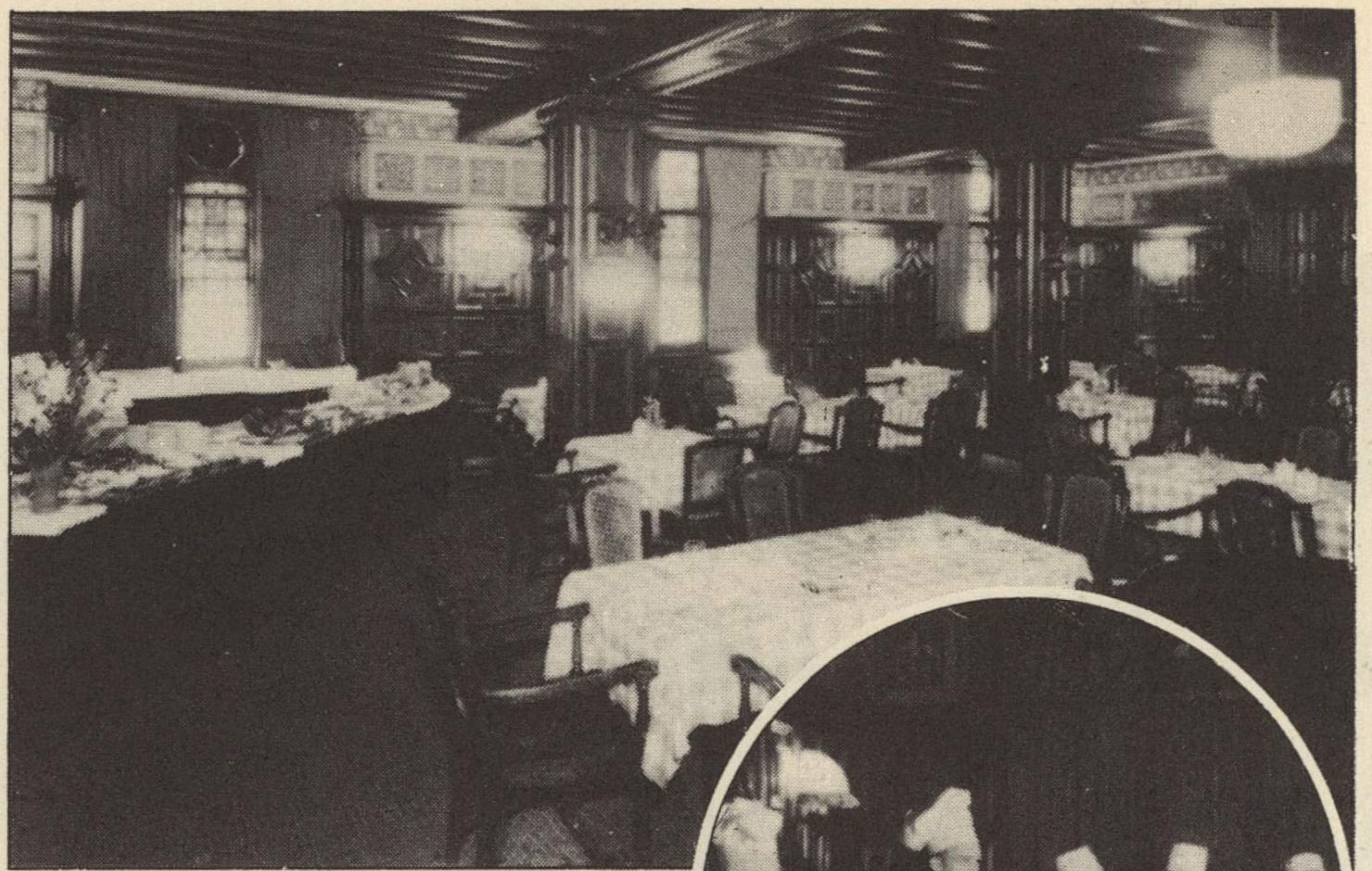
Efficiently trained staff accustomed to handling convention crowds and large functions.

One entire floor of large sample rooms.

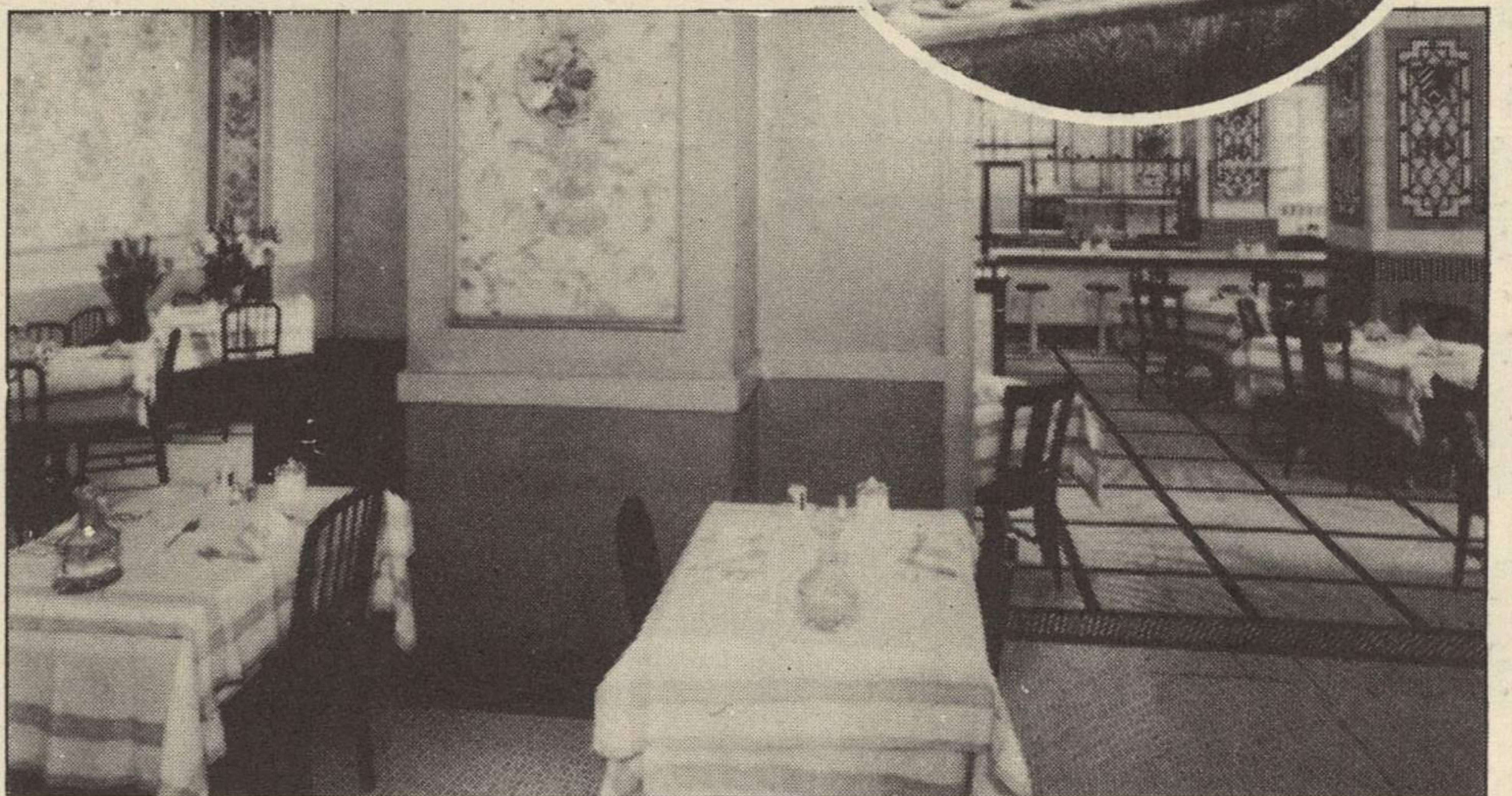
Motion picture facilities available.

Permanent wires available to link hotel to local broadcasting stations for special events, or national hookups.

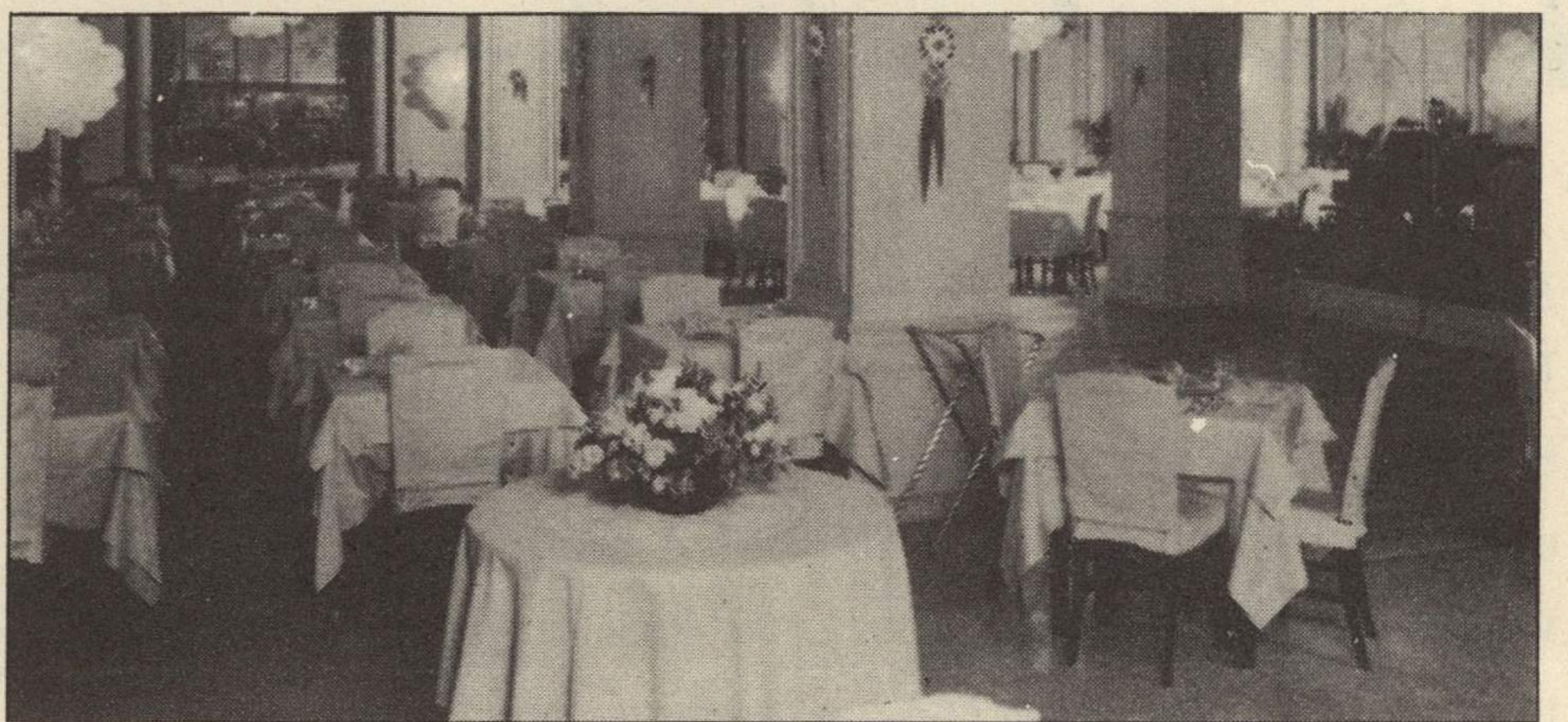
Public parking facilities abound near the hotel, and there are several garages within a block.
