Dear Clyde:

Thanks for your letter of November 29. I am glad to know you have the tickets and are all set for our Rockhurst game in Kansas City on December 12.

The ticket sale arrangement for all the high schools will be the same as last year, namely, that the tickets are to be sold to high school students for 25¢ and the high school selling them is to keep half of the amount of money as their own and the other half is to be turned in to you at the Auditorium. Representatives of each school may get tickets from you.

The coaches you contacted last year were Mel Bishop, of Southwest High, Tom Dorney of Ward, Harold Reade of Shawnee-Mission, and at Rockhurst this year Father Daly is in charge of the high school athletics.

I am sending a copy of this letter to each of these coaches so that they will be advised of the procedure. Mr. Reaves Peters is handling the matter of officials.
