Dear Reaves:

I am sending you a schedule of games, but just this morning I received a letter from Dee Errickson asking that their date be changed at Lawrence from February 1 to January 31. I told him that we would play on February 2 to accommodate him, so that is still up in the air. He writes me about officials and suggests Mike Oberhelman and Cecil Peterson.

Since this is another war year and since we are playing so many service teams I believe it would be much better for us to arrange our officials than to have you go to all that trouble. You handle the officials for the Conference games, but I believe the non-conference officials can be expedited much easier than to bother you with them.

For instance, it is possible that in our Rockhurst game we may get the same officials to work the college and high school games. This hasn't been done as yet, but I see no reason why we should not save money where it is possible. What do you think about it? We are planning to use some of the officers here in some of our service games.

Our prospects are very uncertain as we never have the same line up twice, but I believe we will get ironed out a little later.

In your postscript you state that Lance has been assigned for our games with Oklahoma Aggies. This postscript must have been intended for Bruce Drake as we are not playing the Aggies this year at all, and perhaps won't due to that unfortunate situation on the Lawrence court last year.

If this arrangement on officials does not suit you let me know and we will try to cooperate with you, but economy is the watchword and I think we can handle it better this way until the war is over.
