Dear Mr. Bayles:

When you have the annual painting done on the basement floors of the gymnasium this summer I would like to have the floors sanded and painted in the womens' showers and the area in front of the showers and leading to the door of the swimming pool.

This has been a most satisfactory arrangement on the men's side, and we wish to do away with the unsanitary rubber matting that is now on the floor in the women's end of the basement.

Also, I would like to request again that the toilets in the women's office and the ones in the basement be replaced with more modern toilets. As you know, the dressing room in Miss Hoover's office is separated from the outer office by only a wainscoting partition about ten feet high. The old style toilet is extremely noisy, and it is very embarrassing to use it.

I have an additional request which I trust you will be able to do some time during the summer. I refer to the removal of additional sections of the running track in the balcony of the gymnasium. One corner section has been removed and this has given a fine place for an indoor archery and golf range. If you could remove the other section of the sloping track at the west end and the entire section at the east end of the gymnasium this would give us additional facilities for conducting some of the activities classes indoors. This space is badly needed and I am hopeful that you will be able to clear it for us.
