On campus mail that must be sealed it is not economical to use the University Envelopes which have been printed with lines for six addresses. They cost $75 \, \phi$ per box, whereas the ones without the lines cost only $25 \, \phi$.

Special attention is called to the necessity of saving typewriter ribbon spools. In the near future it will probably be necessary to have an old spool in order to

buy a new one.

Tirss on University delivery trucks are getting thin, and new ones cannot be obtained, which necessitates a gradual curtailment of delivery service. A fact which is regretted, but which cannot be avoided.
