PIANO, VOICE, VIOLIN, VIOLONCELLO, ORGAN

Courses in piano, voice, violin, violoncello, and organ are offered by the Department of Music, with the following credits in the School of Fine Arts. No credit will be allowed for less than two lessons and eight hours practice each week. Additional credit may be had for additional practice by consulting Dean Swarthout.

PIANO. One hour credit for two lessons and eight hours practice each week.

VOICE. One hour credit for two lessons and eight hours practice each week.

VIOLIN. One hour credit for two lessons and eight hours practice each week.

CELLO. One hour credit for two lessons and eight hours practice each week.

ORGAN. One hour credit for two lessons and eight hours practice each week.

College students may secure professional credit for work in piano, voice, violin, and organ. For the new Liberal Arts curriculum see General Catalogue.
