

# BUFFS ON FREE THROW

OREGON STATE ON SHORT END  
63-53 SCORE.

Colorado, Outshot, 24-18, Fr  
Field, Has a 27-5 Margin  
From the Charity  
Line.

Corvallis, Ore., Dec. 4. (AP) —  
The University of Colorado Buffaloes made free throws count as they defeated Oregon State 63-53 in last night's basketball game.

Colorado, third in the N. C. A. A. tournament last year, made only eighteen field goals compared with twenty-four for Oregon State, the defending Pacific Coast conference champion. But on the free throw line, Colorado outscored the Staters 27-5.

The game was tied three times in the first half and was knotted again with just seven minutes remaining. At that point, however, the more experienced Buffaloes pulled ahead to win by the 10-point margin.

Dave Gambie, Oregon State sophomore forward, was high scorer of the game with twenty-two. He fouled out with six minutes left to play and his departure hurt the Staters.

Bill Peterson, Colorado guard, was high for his team with eighteen. Center George Hanna had sixteen and Forward Jim Ranglos had thirteen for the winners.
