

Jayhawks Keep Big 7 Mark Clean

KANSAS CITY, Dec. 8.—(AP)—The University of Kansas Jayhawks squeaked past Wichita's Wheatshockers, 56-55, Wednesday night to keep the Big Seven conference basketball victory streak rolling at six games.

Earlier this week Missouri, Kansas, Colorado, Oklahoma and Kansas State each won over major opponents.

Thursday night's card offers Iowa State against Texas Tech at Ames, Iowa, and Oklahoma against Rice at Houston. Texas Tech has lost by big scores to Missouri and Kansas State this week.

Kansas, which opened its season in a 91-70 victory over Northwestern on Monday, had to turn on the heat in the second half to edge Wichita which was dedicating its new field house before a capacity crowd of 10,000.

Wichita, which got a 14-point shooting performance from Forward Don Woodworth, raced to a 28-23 halftime lead, but wilted early in the second half to allow Kansas to pull ahead 36-31.

Forward Bill Brainard and Center Lou Johnson each scored 15 points for Kansas.
