Defeats Tec

COLUMBIA, MO.—(U) Norman Stewart broke an all-time Missouri single-game scoring record with 35 points Monday night as the Tigers handed Texas Tech its first defeat of the season, 92-60.

Stewart, an All-Big Seven guard last season, also set an individual game mark for field goals, connecting on 14 of 26 shots for 54 percent. He also snagged 19 rebounds.

The old scoring record of 33 points was set in 1953 by Bob Reiter. The Tigers as a team hit a red-hot 58 percent of their shots from the floor while Tech could muster only 31 percent.

Missouri, with Stewart setting the pace, built up a 51-20 half-time lead. Tech came back in the second half with a full-court press, but the Tigers continued to pour it on with their lead never cut.
