

Oregon Falls To Buffaloes

EUGENE, Ore., Dec. 6.—A well-balanced, fast-moving attack carried the University of Colorado to a 68-49 basketball victory over the University of Oregon here Monday night for the Buffs' second cage win of the year against Pacific Coast foes.

Saturday the Buff quintet opened its cage season with a 63-53 triumph over Oregon State.

Bill Peterson and Bob Helzer each scored 11 points for the Silver and Gold while George Hannah and Dave Mowbray checked in with 10 apiece to add to the attack before a crowd of 4,867.

After the game was tied, 4-4, in the opening minute of play, the Buffs rolled up a 40-21 half-time lead. Oregon, paced by 6-7 Center Max Anderson, cut the margin to 11 points at the start of the second half, but Colorado recovered and won going away.

Anderson was the game's high scorer with 13 points, garnered on four baskets and five free throws.

Jim Ranglos tossed in two buckets in the opening minute and Oregon tied it up for the only time in the contest on Anderson's two free throws and goal, 4-4.

Mel Coffman's fielder sent the Buffs ahead to stay after only

four minutes of action. After Anderson sank another basket, Oregon was scoreless from the field while Colorado was building up a 12-point margin.

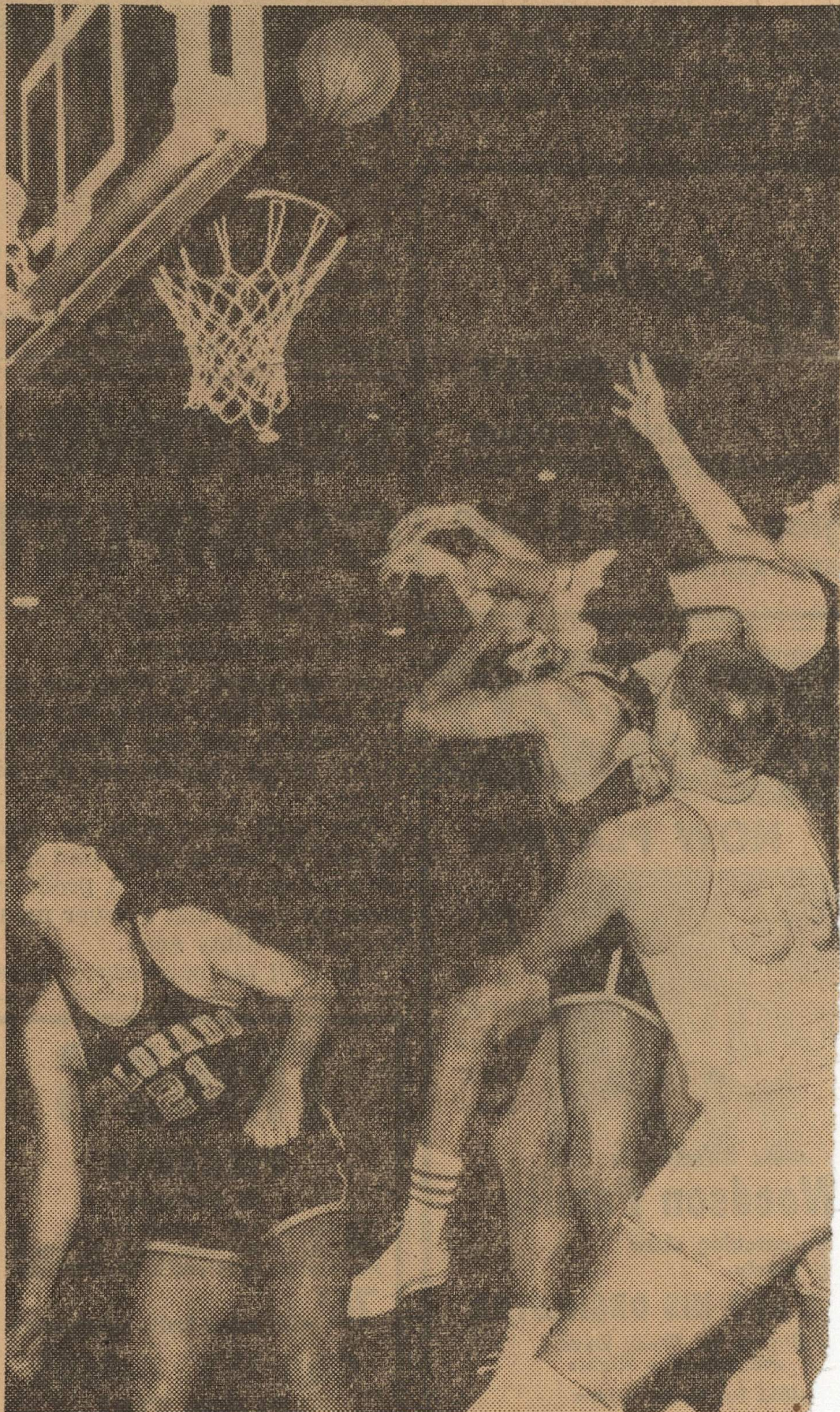
Oregon's Phil McHugh scored with nine minutes gone to pull the Webfoots to within 8 points, 18-10. Oregon staged its only real challenge in the opening minutes of the second period by tallying 7 points while holding Colorado scoreless.

Oregon out-rebounded the Buf-

faloes, 48-35. Anderson led in this department with 12. Hannah had 7 for the Buffs.

Colorado shot well from outside the defense and scored a number of times driving in from the post. Mowbray appeared to be the key man of the Colorado attack. Both Hannah and Jim Jochems, another 6-foot 7-inch center, were effective post men.

The Buffs did well at the free throw line making 22 in 28 with Helzer sinking 7 in his 8 attempts.
